#### "A Hanukkah Project: Daniel Libeskind's Line of Fire"

Mon Dec 6, Tue Dec 7, Sat Dec 11, Sun Dec 12 11am–5:45pm; Thu Dec 9 11am–8pm; Fri Dec 10 11am–4pm. The Jewish Museum, 1109 Fifth Ave at 92nd St (212-423-3200, [thejewishmuseum.org](http://thejewishmuseum.org)). Subway: 4, 5, 6 to 86th St; 6 to 96th St. \$12, children under 12 free.

Families can celebrate the Festival of Lights at this exhibit by Daniel Libeskind, the renowned architect who won the World Trade Center design competition in 2003. Libeskind uses various Hanukkah lamps from the museum's collection to create a stunning installation. All ages.

Families can celebrate the Festival of Lights by taking a spin around the ice rink in Central Park and watching as a giant ice menorah is lit for the sixth night of Hanukkah. A light dinner, donuts and hot beverages are included in the evening's festivities. All ages.

Celebrate the Festival of Lights around a giant menorah, which will be lit at Grand Army Plaza each evening of Hanukkah. The fanfare surrounding the nightly event includes live music and hot latkes. All ages.
